CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1.1 This competition is open to players who are full members of an affiliated golf club with the counties of Bedfordshire, Cambs & Hunts, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk or Suffolk.

Regulations

- 2.1 Entries shall be limited to 40 pairs.
2.2 A ballot will be held after the closing date. Entries balloted out will be kept on a reserve list.
2.3 The draw for partners will be made after the ballot.
2.4 Competitors must report to the organiser on arrival.
2.5 A current CONGU Handicap certificate must be produced before the end of play - failure to do so will mean disqualification.
2.6 The Committee has the authority to arrange/alter tee times.
2.7 In all matters, the decision of the Competition Committee is final.
2.8 In the event of adverse conditions, the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result.
2.9 A pair withdrawing after the closing date must inform the organiser **Jocelyn Faris (Tel: 07876350307 Email: mjfaris@uk2.net.)** Entry fees are non refundable after the closing date unless the organiser has a substitute.

Conditions

- 2.1 The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules as approved by the Competition Committee.
2.2 The competition shall consist of 36 holes Foursomes medal.
2.3 The handicap allowance will be as per CONGU Regulations for foursomes medal.
2.4 In the event of a tie after 36 holes the winners will be decided on a count back over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card of the final round. Players may only win one prize.
2.5 If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in stroke play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
2.6 The ball used must be on the R&A Conforming Ball list. Penalty – Disqualification.
2.7 Distance measuring devices cannot be used. Penalty – Disqualification
2.8 No buggies or mobile phones allowed on the course.
2.9 In the event of extreme weather conditions or the course being unfit for play the following signals will be used: 1 long blast of the klaxon for suspension of play and a series of short blasts for resumption of play. Please be aware of RULE 6-8b.
2.10 The Competition Committee will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play.
2.11 Trousers and shorts must be tailored. Shirts must have a collar. Golf shoes can have metal or soft spikes. Denim wear is not permitted. No shorts in the lounge/dining room in the evening.

CATERING ARRANGEMENTS Coffee will be available from 7.30a.m. (Payable)

Sandwiches and Chips (Light Lunch) (Included in entry)

Meals available after 36 holes and should be ordered and paid for at check-in, before the start of play.
