- 1.1 The Championship is open to female golfers who are members of a recognised golf club within the counties of Bedfordshire, Cambs & Hunts, Essex, Hertfordshire, Norfolk and Suffolk; who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of R & A Rules Limited and who hold an Active CONGU Exact handicap or equivalent of not more than 16.4 at the date of entry.

Regulations

- 2.1 Entries shall be limited to 60.
- 2.2 In the event of entries exceeding this number preference will be given to players with the lower Exact Handicaps at the closing date. Please update the organiser (**Margaret McCall - Tel: 01223 276779; email: margaret.mccall@ntlworld.com**) of any changes to the Exact Handicap prior to the closing date. Those entrants balloted out will be placed on a waiting list. Unsuccessful entrants will have their entry fees refunded.
- 2.3 The draw for partners will be made after the ballot.
- 2.4 Entry forms accompanied by the appropriate entry fee must reach the organiser by the closing date.
- 2.5 Any competitor who is aged under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 2.6 Competitors must register at the registration desk no later than 30 minutes before their first tee-off time.
- 2.7 A current Active CONGU Handicap certificate or equivalent must be produced not later than the end of the first round - failure to do so will mean disqualification. A player so disqualified may act as a marker.
- 2.8 A pair withdrawing after the closing date must inform the organiser. Entry fees are non refundable after the closing date unless the organiser has a substitute.
- 2.9 The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason for its decision.
- 2.10 The Committee has the authority to arrange/alter tee times.
- 2.11 In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Committee reserves the right to alter the format of the Championship in order to achieve a result.
- 2.12 In all matters the decision of the Committee is final.

Conditions

- 2.1 The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules as approved by the Committee.
- 2.2 The Championship shall consist of two 18 hole Strokeplay rounds.
- 2.3 In the event of a tie for the Champion there will be a sudden death play-off. All other ties will be decided on a count back over the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s) on the card of the final round. No individual may receive more than one prize.
- 2.4 Distance measuring devices cannot be used. Penalty – Disqualification
- 2.5 Competitors shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless prior permission has been granted from the Committee. Penalty – Disqualification.
- 2.6 Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. Penalty – Disqualification.
- 2.7 The ball used must be on the R & A Conforming Ball list. Penalty – Disqualification.
- 2.8 If a player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant the waiving of the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is TWO STROKES in stroke play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is DISQUALIFICATION.
- 2.9 The Committee will monitor the pace of play and will take action under the Rules of Golf if players are considered to be delaying play.
